Friends,

Some of these ideas have merit, and some come without any scriptural basis, but most are speculative at best. The bottom line I believe is this: 1) There is reality to the Resurrection; 2) There is a Heaven; 3) There is a second coming of Jesus, whether it is on this side of eternity or on the other side when we die and stand before Him; 4) We must be prepared at all times to know that we are just one breath away from meeting Christ; 5) Jesus promises eternal life and knowing there is eternal life should guide you as to how you live your daily life; 6) Nothing can separate us from the love of God; 7) Jesus will be our advocate before the Father; 8) Death does not have the final word.

Without the Resurrection, we have nothing to celebrate. Jesus not only conquered sin, he conquered death, which was and is the ultimate consequence of sin. Praise God that you and I do not have to fear death as a believer and follower of Jesus Christ. Jesus conquered both our sins and our fear of death through His death, burial, and resurrection. Now go and be a disciple of Jesus Christ by passing on to others this great message of hope. Become the
