Give us a call and we will walk you through the process, and work with you as a family so that your students can achieve their best in a very nurturing environment.

As a school, BBLA offers financial assistance through the "Step Up Program" sponsored by the State of Florida. The Step Up Financial Assistance Program is currently accepting first time students who have not received financial aid. Right now if you have an interest, as the parent of a first time student, you would go to their web site (www.StepUpForStudent), register your interest, and you will be placed on a list. Step Up will then notify you through e-mail letting you know that you can go and complete an application for the coming school year. It is important that you get on the list, because the earlier you register, the better off you will be in qualifying for funding. This is a first-come first-served application process, because, just as anything else, there is limited funding. In registering, you will need to use the school name "Bright Beginnings Learning Academy," and they will ask you for our school number which is 8419.

There is no cost in taking the time to check us out and in placing your name on the Step Up Financial Assistance list. Pray about this possibility for your family, let others in your circle of friends know about us, and consider enrolling your student with us for the 2019-2020 school year.

This past weekend we looked at how we might "Train our Minds." We discussed how there has been this on-going debate as to the difference between our brain and our minds. One thought is that the brain is like the hardware of a computer, where as the mind is like the software in a computer. So to equate this to everyday life, it is your thoughts and your emotions that represent your mind, the software in your brain. Our thoughts and emotions direct our behavior and actions. "All Aspects of human nature are influenced by what we do with our thoughts," as stated by Dallas Willard, a writer and theologian. Willard goes on to contend that our thoughts are our "first freedom," for they are a gift that allows us to think through how we will act and behave. It is the mind that can conceive both the visible and the invisible. So if we are going to train our minds, we need to "Think about what we Think about."

One of the techniques that can be useful in training the "Mind" is to study God's Word and spend time meditating on scripture. When we meditate and memorize, we plant the word deep within our minds and the scripture helps to guide our thoughts and emotions. Meditation from a Christian perspective is to fill our minds with the appropriate thoughts. So in filling our minds with God's Word, it allows us to know and love God more deeply, because if you do not control what you think, you will never control what you do.

The last suggestion that was made on Sunday as a way of training your mind was to **Write It**, **Think It**, **Confess It**, **until you Believe It**. As was said last week, part of training your mind is being able to defeat strongholds in your life. Strongholds are things that keep you from living a life that is guided by God. If we are going to control what we do, we have to identify the strongholds and defeat them, or as scripture says, let Christ take captive our thoughts and make them obedient to him. When we write it, think it, confess it, we will be guided by God's Word, and then we will come to believe it. This action becomes a way in which God can renew our minds because our lives will always move in the direction of our "**Strongest Thoughts."** If you will Change your Thinking, you will Change your Life.

WEEKEND SERMON

This weekend we will dive into how we can recognize the things that we need to change, and then "Reframe" our perspective in how we see life, circumstances and situations. This series is tilted, "Reframing Your Thinking," so we will look at some principles on how we can reframe our thinking. Think about this: "The life you have is a Reflection of the Thoughts you Think." Hope you will join me this weekend as we dive deeper into how the Apostle Paul offers us a perspective on reframing our thinking, and see how he did this in his own life. You always bless others and me when you are present in worship. Come and be a blessing.
